Before taking the instrument home, we will need you to sign an agreement form, acknowledging that you are responsible for looking after and returning the instrument.

The Tax-Free Childcare portal has now been set up at Walnut Tree Walk. This is a UK-wide government scheme to help working parents with the cost of childcare. For every £8 you pay towards your child's childcare, the government will add an extra £2.
