Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope that you have all had an enjoyable and restful half-term break. I will write to you again on Tuesday following tomorrow's expected announcement from Boris Johnson with details of the wider reopening of schools.

In the meantime, on Monday each week (starting tomorrow) there will be an additional Google Meets session for all of the children working at home. The purpose of the Monday session is for the teacher to introduce learning for the week, as well as there being an opportunity for children to speak and ask questions. The teacher is likely to mute all of the children at the start of this session when they are speaking or presenting, but they might need to un-mute themselves later if they are invited to speak. These Monday sessions will be for half a class at a time so the teacher will be doing two sessions. These sessions will not be for the Key Worker children in school as they are already being supported with their learning by adults in school.

The times are as follows. Please check Google Classroom tomorrow morning first thing to see which of the groups your child is in so that they turn up at the right time. They will not be allowed in to a session unless it is the one they are invited to.
