As well our 'Bearpee' Challenge for Children in Need, the children also took part in a decorate a biscuit competition.








A group of Year 5 children have been having weekly Maths Masterclasses at Kings Maths School. These sessions have included not only Maths activities, but also physics and technology lessons.
