Spring Term Parent Conference Meetings

Clothing for school

A reminder that although we do not have a school uniform, it is important that children are dressed in clothing that is **appropriate** for practical and sometimes messy activities as well as being age appropriate. Children must always be wearing footwear that is suitable for PE or physical activities so trainers are ideal. No crocs or flip flops please. **Children should not come in wearing fancy dress costumes** (other than on days like World Book Day yesterday!) as they can be a big distraction. We do advise that parents **write or sew their children's names on to their clothing** as we have an enormous amount of lost property each term. For Health and Safety reasons, please no jewellery, as accidents can happen. Smart watches such as Apple Watches or any watch that can send/receive messages or that can take photos are not allowed at any time. We do not allow the wearing of any type of makeup or nail varnish.
